All-School Field Trips are included in the program fee and are open to all (non-architecture) students. Note that trips and dates are subject to change.

Included in the field trips are: round trip transportation, museum admissions, hotel (on overnight trips) and on-site lectures. For most trips, you are responsible for paying for your own meals.

Sign Up Policies and Procedures:

On Friday of Orientation, you will be given an All-School Field Trip Form to complete. You will sign-up separately (in person in the SLO) for one of the Insider's Florence trips. Please return your completed form to the Student Life Office starting **Monday, January 15, 2018. Sign up for the Insider's will take place at this time as well.**

*We recommend that you submit your form as soon as possible, as spaces on each field trip are limited. Sign-ups are on a first-come first-served basis. Even if an All-School Trip is required for a course, you still must sign up for it.

Deposit and Cancellation Policy: Upon submittal of your form, a **20 euro deposit in cash** is required. If you are absent from one of the trips you signed up for (including the Insider's), you will lose your deposit and be ineligible to attend the rest of the trips without submitting another deposit, this time of **50 euro**. If you must cancel a trip, you will lose your deposit. For day trips only, you can, alternatively, find a student replacement by the Tuesday prior to departure so as not to lose your deposit. Exceptions will be made only in the case of a documented medical issue. If you have attended all trips you signed up for, at the end of the semester your deposit will be returned to you.

Group Transportation and Independent Travel

All SU Florence field trips provide group transportation. You will be expected to depart and return with the group. Should you wish to make personal travel plans you must do so at your own expense.

For security reasons please make sure to do the following:

- Immediately inform one of the staff members listed on your itinerary as emergency contact.
- Fill out the Student Travel Form on our webpage.

Course-related field trips are open only to students enrolled in the class and cover only material pertinent to that course. The course fee for each class covers transportation, museum admissions and hotels for students. This fee is not refundable unless you have a class conflict; the fee is refunded in U.S. dollars and sent to your billing address in the U.S.) Course related field trips are **required** for students signed up for the course and are listed in the course syllabus. Failure to attend will count as an absence.

A Word of Advice—Note carefully the Field Trip Schedule.

We have scheduled more than fifty field trips each semester spread over 10 weekends. Be sure to plan your personal schedule around your required course-related field trips and in such a way that you can take full advantage of the many All-School Trips that are included in your program fee. Keep in mind your academic responsibilities, class assignments and schedule of exams.
