Documentation of the courses your college has pre-approved will facilitate your registration and the transfer of credits to your degree program.*

- **Newhouse School of Public Communications:** Open to students enrolled in professional Public Communications degree programs ONLY and subject to Newhouse review prior to acceptance by Syracuse University.
- **College of Visual and Performing Arts:** Open to students enrolled in professional degree programs ONLY and subject to portfolio review prior to acceptance by Syracuse University.

It is important to seek approval for several alternate courses. This will facilitate your registration in the event of a schedule conflict, closed course, or course cancellation.
