*Program fee includes:

- All-school orientation, general field trips, and cultural activities

- Pre-departure materials and advising
- Fortification of the broad support in place for Syracuse Abroad students

**Meals

***Personal expenses and travel

Includes hotel and travel during the 10-day break period, as well as communications expenses, laundry, weekend travel, and other sundries during the program period.

Other Billable Costs:

Mandatory Course Fees: \$25-\$1,125; invoiced after course registration
