*Program fee includes:

**Meals

Host family: Students placed with a host family receive 14 meals weekly.

Residence hall: Students share a double room with a private bath and kitchenette. Three meals per day are provided during the program period in the residence hall cafeteria.

***Personal expenses and travel

Includes hotel and travel during the 10-day spring break period, as well as communications expenses, laundry, weekend travel, and other sundries during the program period

Other Billable Costs:

Mandatory Course Fees: \$25-\$90; invoiced after course registration

Study at Foreign Universities: Program fee varies subject to student's registration and housing requirements. The academic calendars at foreign universities may differ from the Syracuse Center academic calendar and may require additional housing days based on the student's registration. This billing may occur after the program has begun.

Marine Ecology Signature Seminar: \$335 (pays for PADI certification)

Charges for tuition, program fee, course fees, and Signature Seminar are fixed and billed through the Syracuse University Bursar system. Other expenses are estimated based on current information and are subject to change due to inflation and fluctuating exchange rates.
