

Short-Term Student Visa Packet

Spring 2019

IMPORTANT NOTES

- You must apply for your student visa online by November 15, 2018. Applications will not be accepted more than three months in advance. There is an application fee of approximately \$130 (£93) that can only be paid online with a Visa or MasterCard. It will take approximately three weeks for the UK Visa and Immigration Office to process your application; it will not be possible for you to travel internationally during that time. Guidelines for completing the online application are on pages 2-4 of this packet.
- The last step of the online application is to schedule an appointment for your biometric scan. You must bring the following documents to your appointment:
 - Printed appointment confirmation (you will receive this via e-mail after you schedule the appointment online)
 - Valid travel document (passport)
 - o I-20/IAP-66 or Alien Registration card
 - o Printed online visa application
- After your biometric appointment you will mail the following documents to the British Consulate in NYC:

DOCUMENTS TO SUBMIT

- 1. Printed <u>visa application</u> form
- 2. Official Passport
 - Passport must be signed
 - o Passport must have at least one blank page to affix the visa

- 3. Provide a copy of your I-20/IAP-66 or Alien Registration card in addition to your national passport
- 4. Letter of Verification (provided by Syracuse Abroad Admissions Counselor)
- 5. Additional documents as shown on your application

 Documents about your finances may be required, at the end of your application it will

 provide you with a list of additional items you need to submit, possibilities detailed here
- 6. Prepaid Express Mail Envelope
 This must be purchased through UPS (Federal Express and USPS are not accepted).
 You also have the option of purchasing a next-day, trackable return label through the UKVI partner, VFS Global, after you complete the online application. If you choose this option, you must include a printout of the Return Airway Bill (AWB) with your application.

Additional Note: If you plan to travel outside of the UK for personal or course-related travel during your semester, it is your responsibility to research and obtain any additional visa before you depart (such as a <u>Schengen Visa</u>).
