Program Fee

- Students placed with host family receive 12 meals weekly
- Students placed in apartments (Architecture and Studio Art) have rent/utilities paid, and receive a cash allowance to partially cover meal expenses

- Membership with International SOS Assistance, a medical and security advisory service

- Includes services not covered by tuition and for which a separate fee is not charged

Personal expenses and travel

- Includes hotel and travel during the 10 day break period, as well as communication expenses, laundry, weekend travel, and other sundries during the program period
