### Program Fee

- Students housed in shared apartments with kitchenette and Wi-Fi
- Signature Seminar (transportation, hotel accommodation, and some group meals)
- Access to CityU facilities, including a sports complex, pool, and library
- All-school orientation and general field trips & cultural activities
- Syracuse Abroad Insurance includes emergency travel insurance
- Membership with International SOS Assistance, a medical and security advisory service
- One year digital subscription to the NY Times
- Pre-departure materials and advising
- Fortifies the broad support we have in place for our students
- Includes services not covered by tuition and for which a separate fee is not charged

### Meals

- Estimate includes three meals a day, some prepared in the flat and some purchased at nearby facilities

### Study at Foreign University

- Eligible students studying at City U. may have an adjusted program fee. This billing adjustment may occur after the program has begun, depending on when we confirm housing placement

Charges for tuition and program fee are fixed and billed through the Syracuse University bursar system. Other expenses are estimated based on current information and are subject to change due to inflation and fluctuating exchange rates.
