- Each experience is designed for the student to take in what Madrid has to offer and put to practice what was learned in the classroom.

allow you to collect stamps for a
monetary prize at the end of the semester.

How does the passport system work?

When you arrive to Madrid you will receive the MadWorld Passport. In this passport, **for each MadWorld cultural experience you participate in**, **you will receive a stamp in your passport**.

There are many different types of stamps that correspond to different experiences. In the following slide you will learn about the different categories, how they work, what rewards you can receive by getting these stamps, and how to sign-up.

When you receive **8+ stamps**, which


includes one "MadConvo" and one

50€ and Certificate of Participation.

In order to receive reimbursement for participating in MadWorld Passport experiences, there are 3 levels that you can obtain

Creative Reflection Submission



You can also submit a creative reflection to receive an **additional 15€** in any level.


We encourage submissions in the form of:

How to sign up for MadWorld cultural experiences?




Students may sign up on a weekly basis through the Syracuse Madrid App!

Costs and deposits

If the activity falls on a Friday, the information session will be held on Thursday.




Study Tours have a 10€ deposit.
