about the MadWorld
Passport Program**



- The MadWorld activity program allows students to experience Madrid's political, social and cultural life.
- Each experience is designed for the student to take in what Madrid has to offer and put to practice what was learned in the classroom.

Each student will receive a **Syracuse Madrid Passport** that will allow you to **collect stamps** for a **monetary prize** at the end of the semester.



The MadWorld Passport Program



How does the passport system work?

When you arrive to Madrid you will receive the MadWorld Passport. In this passport, **for each MadWorld cultural experience you participate in, you will receive a stamp in your passport.**

There are many different types of stamps that correspond to different experiences. In the following slide you will learn about the different categories, how they work, what rewards you can receive by getting these stamps, and how to sign-up.

The cultural experiences have been divided into 4 categories

El Faro Residents:

- Students may participate in **El Faro's PlanGO activities** however, only pre-approved activities will count towards the MadWorld passport program.

Homestay:

- Students may receive a Housing stamp by spending time with your host family. Visual proof must be submitted to receive a stamp.

Activities may include, but are not limited to:

- Going to the theater, movies, opera, etc.
- Visiting their "pueblo"
- Celebrating a local holiday

LEVEL OTTO

When you receive **3 stamps**:

Syracuse Madrid

Certificate of Participation,

signed by

Director Dieter Roberto Kuehl.



LEVEL MADRID

When you receive **5 stamps**, which **includes**

one Housing Experience:

15€ deposited in your SPARK card along

with the **Certificate of Participation.**



LEVEL ESPAÑA

When you receive **8+ stamps**, which

includes one “MadConvo” and one

Housing Experience:

50€ and Certificate of Participation.

In order to receive reimbursement for participating in
MadWorld Passport experiences,
there are 3 levels that you can obtain

Creative Reflection Submission



You can also submit a creative reflection to receive an **additional 15€** in any level.

We encourage submissions in the form of:

Blog or Vlog entry for the Syracuse Madrid Website

A photograph or artwork

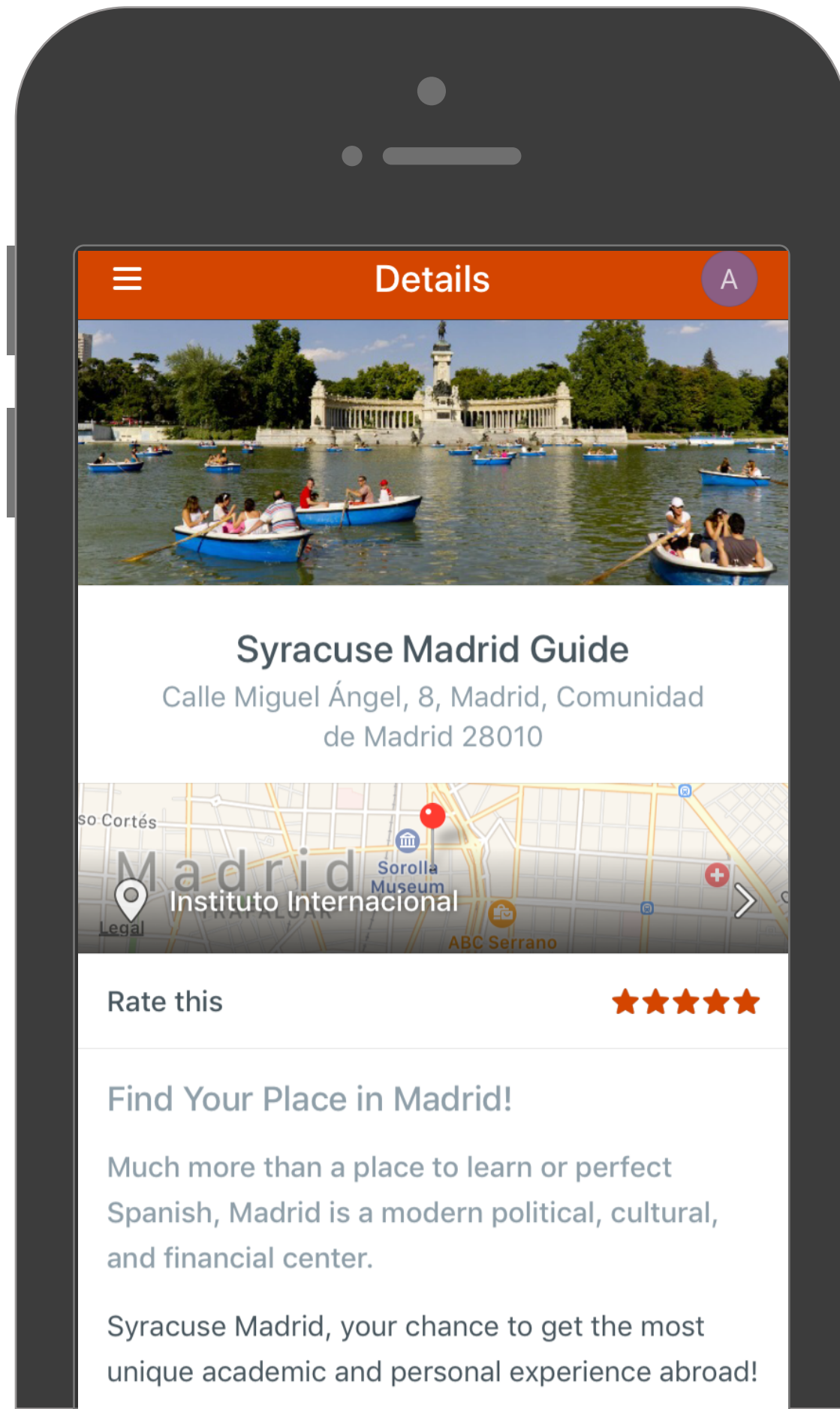
A reflective writing piece, reviews of the activity or journal entry

experiences?**

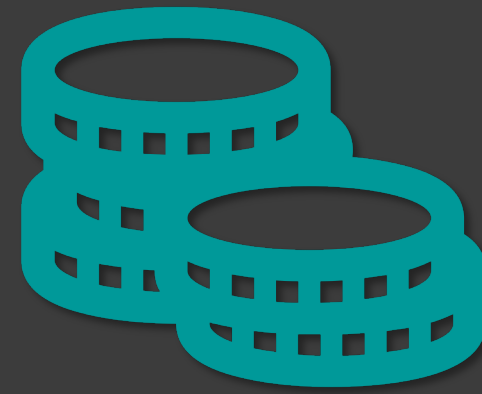


Students may **sign up** on a **weekly basis** through the **Syracuse Madrid App!**

Sign-ups are on a first-come-first-served basis.

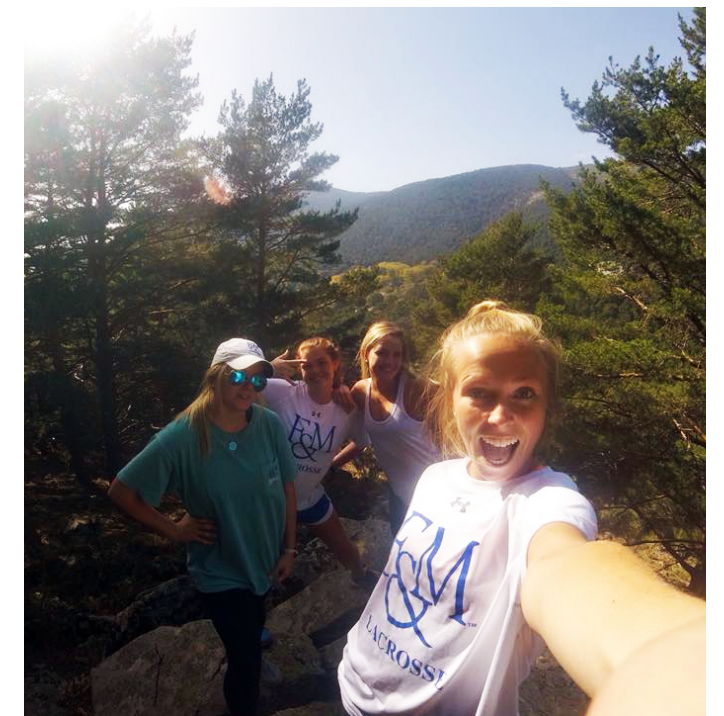


Costs and deposits



Certain cultural experiences have a 5 euro cost. These include:

- Cooking workshops
- Tapas crawl
- Hiking trips



Some MadWorld cultural experiences will also have a **mandatory information session**

These information sessions will occur on the **same day** of the cultural experiences from **12:00 – 12:30.**

If the activity falls on a Friday, the information session will be held on Thursday.



Study Tours have a 10€ deposit.

Deposits will be returned on the day of the trip by the professor in charge.



Some of the study tours we offer this semester are to places such as:

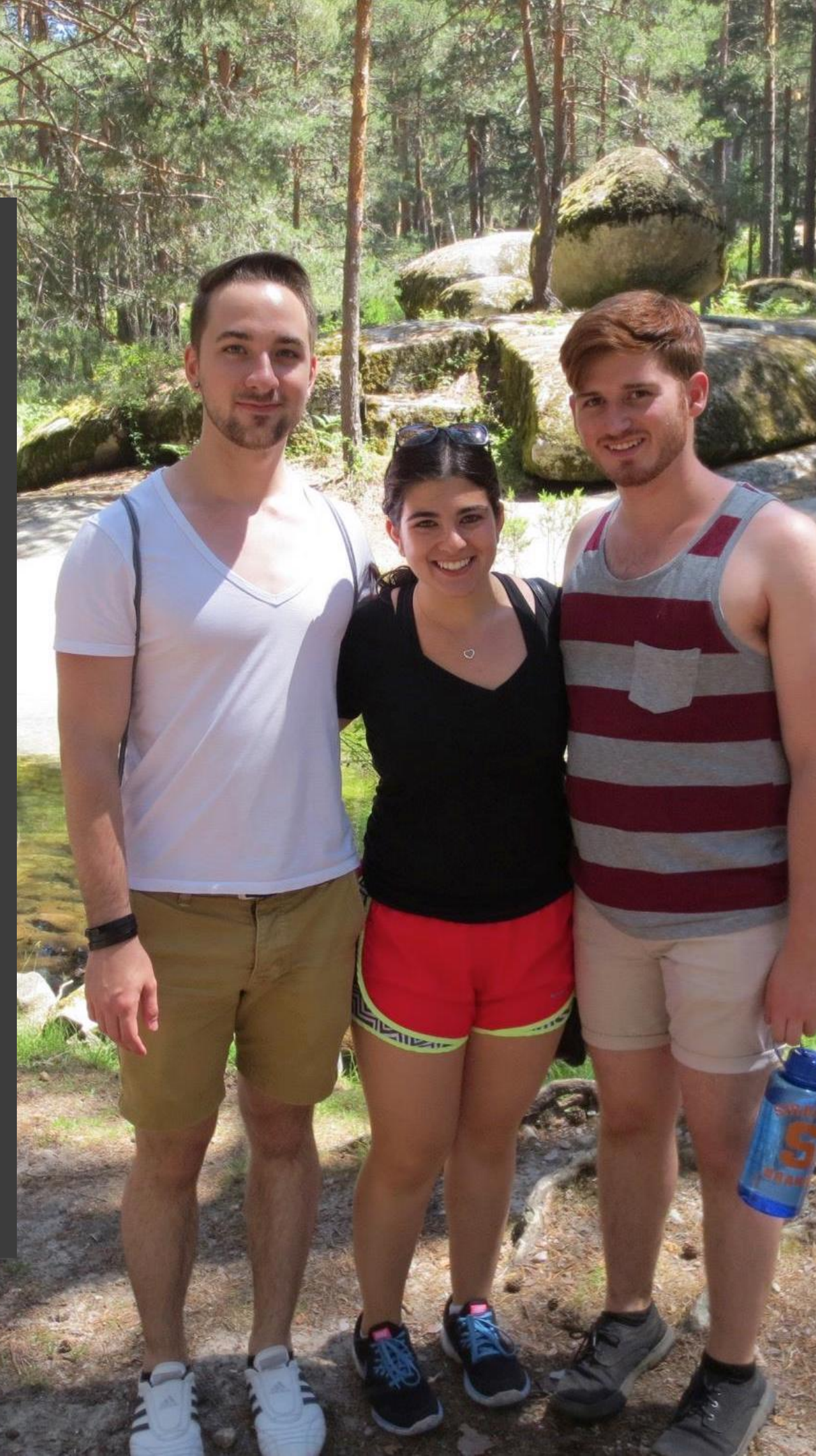
- Cuenca
