What is the

MadWorld Passport

Program?







- The MadWorld program allows students to experience Madrid's political, social and cultural life.
- Each experience is designed for the student to take in what Madrid has to offer and put to practice what is learned in the classroom.

Each student can pick up a
Syracuse Madrid Passport that will
allow you to collect stamps for a
certificate at the end of the semester.

How does the passport system work?

- Once you're in Madrid, you can pick up your Passport in the Academics Office (room 204)!
- For each MadWorld cultural experience you participate in, you will receive a stamp in your passport.
- There are different stamps that correspond to various types of experiences. In the following slides you'll learn about the categories, how they work, and how to sign-up.

When you participate in MadWorld Passport experiences, there are 3 levels that you can obtain.



LEVEL OTTO

When you receive 3 stamps!



LEVEL MADRID

When you receive 5 stamps!



LEVEL ESPAÑA

When you receive 8+ stamps!

At the end of the semester, you'll receive a Certificate of Participation!

AND, by participating, you'll get to meet new people and participate in activities that you'd probably not do on your own!



Study Tours (Day Trips)!

Explore the city with a Syracuse Madrid professor or staff member and return to Madrid that same day!







Day trips we have taken in the past have been to places such as TOLEDO & SEGOVIA!



























Reina Sofia


