### Program Fee

Santiago: Cuenca, Ecuador Immersion program fee includes 4 week intensive language pre-semester program in Cuenca, Ecuador

- Students placed with host family receive 3 meals per day, 7 days a week
- All-school orientation and general field trips & cultural activities
- Syracuse Abroad Insurance includes emergency travel insurance
- Membership with International SOS Assistance, a medical and security advisory service
- Pre-departure materials and advising
- Fortifies the broad support we have in place for our students
- Includes services not covered by tuition and for which a separate fee is not charged

### Personal expenses and travel

- Includes communication expenses, laundry, weekend travel, and other sundries during the program period.

Charges for tuition, program fee, course fees and Signature Seminar are fixed and billed through the Syracuse University Bursar system. Other expenses are estimated based on current information and are subject to change due to inflation and fluctuating exchange rates.
