Program Fee

- All-school orientation and general field trips & cultural activities
- Semester transportation allowance
- Syracuse Abroad Insurance includes emergency travel insurance
- Membership with International SOS Assistance, a medical and security advisory service
- Pre-departure materials and advising
- Fortifies the broad support we have in place for our students
- Includes services not covered by tuition and for which a separate fee is not charged

Host Family

- Students placed with host family receive 14 meals weekly
- Host family provides linens, does laundry & cleans room weekly

Residence Housing

- Double room with a private bath & kitchenette; fully catered (3 meals per day during the program period)
- Single room with a private bath & kitchenette; fully catered (3 meals per day during the program period)
- Includes utilities; weekly cleaning service; linens & towels; onsite, coin-operated washers & dryers; access to photocopying & printing services for a fee; 24-hour onsite staff

Personal expenses and travel

- Includes hotel and travel during the spring break, as well as communication expenses, laundry, weekend travel, and other sundries during the program period

Charges for tuition, program fee, course fees and Signature Seminar are fixed and billed through the Syracuse University Bursar system. Other expenses are estimated based on current information and are subject to change due to inflation and fluctuating exchange rates.
