Program Fee

- Students stay in single room dormitory suites in Wroclaw; shared kitchen, laundry facilities, and Wi-Fi provided
- Signature Seminar (transportation, hotel accomodation with breakfast and some group meals)
- Three weekend trips during the program period
- Monthly transportation pass
- Syracuse Abroad Insurance includes emergency travel insurance
- Membership with International SOS Assistance, a medical and security advisory service
- Pre-departure materials and advising
- Fortifies the broad support we have in place for our students
- Includes services not covered by tuition and for which a separate fee is not charged
