Program Fee

- All Students placed with host families and receive 12 meals weekly
- All-School orientation, All-School travel, and cultural activities throughout the semester
- A semester tram and bus pass
- Syracuse Abroad Insurance includes emergency travel insurance
- Membership with International SOS Assistance, a medical and security advisory service
- Pre-departure materials and advising
- Fortifies the broad support we have in place for our students
- Includes services not covered by tuition and for which a separate fee is not charged
- A higher Program fee for the Music Program is due to later start date, extra music expenses and travel
- A higher Program fee for the Sciences Po and IIEF program is due to later end date and extra student support services

Personal expenses and travel

- Includes hotel and travel during the break period, as well as communication expenses, laundry, weekend travel, and other sundries during the program period

Charges for tuition, program fee and course fees are fixed and billed through the Syracuse University bursar system. Other expenses are estimated based on current information and are subject to change due to inflation and fluctuating exchange rates.
