### Program Fee

- Students placed in iQ housing
- Includes a single room with a double bed, study desk, closet, private shower and washroom
- Bedding and linens provided, towels not included
- A fully equipped shared kitchen (kitchen basics included)
- Utilities covered
- Wi-Fi
- Access to laundry facilities, includes a £50 credit toward laundry services; additional funds to be provided by student
- Gym Access
- General orientation, cultural activities, and All-school field trips
- Syracuse Abroad Insurance includes emergency travel insurance
- Membership with International SOS Assistance, a medical & security advisory service
- Pre-departure materials and advising
- Fortifies the broad support we have in place for our students
- Includes services not covered by tuition and for which a separate fee is not charged
- 18+ Oyster card for use in zones 1 & 2 for the program duration
- Support for mental and physical health, including some professional appointments

### Meals

- Estimate includes three meals a day during the program period; assumes students will prepare most meals in the shared kitchen

### Personal expenses and travel

- Includes communication expenses, laundry, weekend travel within the UK, and other sundries during the program period

Charges for tuition, program fee, course fees and Signature Seminar are fixed and billed through the Syracuse University Bursar system.
