Program Fee

- Students placed with host families receive 12 meals weekly
- A unlimited semester tram and bus pass
- Extensive support system to respond to student needs

- Syracuse Abroad Insurance includes emergency travel insurance
- Membership with International SOS Assistance, a medical and security advisory service
- Pre-departure materials and advising

- Includes services not covered by tuition and for which a separate fee is not charged
- A higher Program fee for the UNISTRA, IIEF, Sciences PO, and INSA partner university programs due to additional partner school fees, later end date, and extra student support services
