Program Fee

- Weekend trip three days (two nights)
- Semester transportation allowance, transportation cards
- On-site nursing service
- Mental health services
- Airport transfer cost
- General orientation, cultural activities, and All-school field trips
- Syracuse Abroad Insurance includes emergency travel insurance
- Membership with International SOS Assistance, a medical & security advisory service
- Pre-departure materials and advising
- Fortifies the broad support we have in place for our students
- Includes services not covered by tuition and for which a separate fee is not charged

Host Family

- Students placed with host family receive 14 meals weekly
- Host family provides linens, does laundry & cleans room weekly
- Spring Semester Students Only are responsible for their own housing & meals during the mid-semester break (10 nights); costs are considered out of pocket (not covered by the program fee)

Xior Madrid Retiro

- Double room with a private bath ; kitchenette; 20 breakfasts and 20 additional meals per month
- Includes utilities; weekly cleaning service; linens & towels; onsite, coin-operated washers & dryers; access to photocopying & printing services for a fee; 24-hour onsite staff
- Students are welcome to remain in Xior Madrid Retiro housing during the mid-semester break (10 nights), but meals are not included. Meals will be considered out of pocket costs for the duration of the break (not covered by the program fee)

The Social Hub (TSH)

- Single room with queen-size bed and private bath; shared kitchen among all residents with private mini-pantry; optional meal plan in restaurant¹
- Includes utilities; monthly cleaning service and linen change; 7 tokens/month for onsite laundry; access to co-working space; 24-hour onsite staff

El Faro Residence Housing

- Double room with a private bath; kitchenette; fully catered on weekdays (3 meals per day from Sunday dinner to Friday lunch, during the program period for a total of 15 meals per week)
- Includes utilities; weekly cleaning service; linens & towels; onsite, coin-operated washers & dryers; access to photocopying & printing services for a fee; 24-hour onsite staff
- Students are welcome to remain in El Faro housing during the mid-semester break (10 nights), but meals are not included. Meals will be considered out of pocket costs for the duration of the break (not covered by the program fee)

Galdos Residence Housing

- Double room with a private bath; kitchenette; fully catered on weekdays (3 meals per day from Sunday dinner to Friday lunch, during the program period for a total of 15 meals per week)
- Includes utilities; weekly cleaning service; linens & towels; onsite, coin-operated washers & dryers; access to photocopying & printing services for a fee; 24-hour onsite staff
- Students are welcome to remain in Galdos housing during the mid-semester break (10 nights), but meals are not included. Meals will be considered out of pocket costs for the duration of the break (not covered by the program fee)

Personal expenses and travel

- Includes hotel and travel during the program breaks, as well as communication expenses, weekend travel, and other sundries during the program period
