Study at Partner University Program fee varies subject to student's registration & housing requirements.
The academic calendars at partner universities may differ from the SU Center academic calendar and may require additional housing days based on the student's registration.

Programs at Partner University:

- The **Florence Center & University of Florence (courses taught in English)** program is only offered for Fall 2025. Housing accommodations and Program Fee are the same as the Florence Center options.
- Students enrolled in The **Florence Center & Intensive Language Program at the University of Florence** program are placed in a homestay. The Program Fee will be the fee stated above for **Florence Center - Homestay**. Additional Housing days may be required.

Program Fee

- General orientation, cultural activities, and All-school field trips (overnight trips and one-day trips)
- Syracuse Abroad Insurance, including civil insurance and health travel insurance
- Membership with International SOS Assistance, a medical & security advisory service
- Pre-departure materials and advising, including AMA meetings
- Fortifies the broad support we have in place for our students
- Includes services not covered by tuition and for which a separate fee is not charged
- Arrival Lunch (second day of program)
- Uffizi card
- Bus pass reimbursements
- Library activities
- Site visits to open markets and artisan shops
- Community engagements activities
- Open weekly informal meetings with Italian students to improve the Italian language
- Social and seasonal events
- Extra-Curricular activities
- End of semester events
- Campus Doctor 3 days a week; Counselor once a week
- Emergency phone 24/7

Host Family (Center and Local University Programs):

- Single or shared bedroom with common space and shared bathroom
- 12 meals weekly provided by hosts (7 breakfasts, 5 dinners Mon-Fri)
- Small pantry space and use of microwave (when available). Oven and stove use not permitted.
- Utilities and Wi-Fi covered
- Towels and bedding included
- Weekly load of personal laundry max 6 Kg per week
- Weekly change of towels and bedding
- Weekly bathroom and bedroom cleaning

Apartments:

- Shared bedroom in 2-to-7 person apartment
- Single-Use Bathroom (one per four occupants)
- Shared common kitchen with kitchenware included
- Utilities, Wi-Fi, towels and bedding included
- Washing machine and drying racks within apartment

Ricasoli (Community Apartments) (double, triple):

- Students placed in Double or Triple rooms
- Shared communal bathroom (one per three residents); each floor spans 6-14 students
- Shared common area kitchen per floor, kitchenware included
- Shared common and study areas
- Utilities, Wi-Fi, towels, and bedding included
- On-site laundry facility.
- Air Conditioning provided/heating has limitations
- Towels and sheets changed weekly
- Weekly room cleaning
- Bi-weekly Kitchen, bathrooms and common areas cleaning

Camplus (double room):

- Double room with en suite bath
- 12 meals weekly (7 breakfasts, 5 dinners (excluding holiday dinners) Mon-Fri) served by Camplus restaurant
- Access to on-site shared kitchen, kitchenware NOT included
- Utilities and Wi-Fi covered
- Towels and bedding included
- Weekly room cleaning
- Weekly change of bedding and towels
- Access to small on-site fitness facility

Re Dama (single room):

- Single room with en suite bath
- 12 meals weekly (7 breakfasts, 5 dinners (excluding holiday dinners) Mon-Fri) served by Re Dama restaurant
- Access to on-site shared kitchen, kitchenware NOT included
- Utilities and Wi-Fi covered
- Towels and bedding included
- Weekly room cleaning
- Sheets and towels weekly change

Required Personal Expenses and Travel

- Includes mandatory travel for the program, as well as communication expenses, laundry, and other sundries during the program period

Personal Travel Expenses (Optional)

- Includes hotel and travel during the break period, as well as weekend travel
