#### Program Features

- Students stay in single rooms with kitchen annex in dormitory in Wroclaw. Additional shared kitchen, laundry facilities and Wi-Fi provided.
- Curriculum includes unique opportunities for cultural immersion through almost 4 weeks of travel to diverse locations.
  - Signature Seminar (transportation, hotel accommodations - single or shared rooms - with breakfast and some group meals) involves academics outside of traditional classroom space, including site visits, activities and meetings with scholars, activists and local experts.
  - Three extended weekend study tours during program period
- Three-month Wroclaw public transportation pass provided
- Syracuse Abroad Insurance, including emergency travel insurance
- Membership with International SOS Assistance, a medical and security advisory service
- Pre-departure materials, advising and orientation activities
- Fortifies the broad support we have in place for our students

#### Meals

- Estimates assume students both dine out and prepare meals in the dormitory

#### Airfare

- NYC to Wroclaw
- Wroclaw to NYC

#### Required Personal Expenses and Travel

- Includes mandatory travel for the program, as well as communication expenses, laundry, and other sundries during the program period

- Includes hotel and travel during weekend travel
