Program Fee

- Housing in a London property with 2-4 beds per room (which may be single beds or bunk beds)
- Shared kitchen/Living space and bathroom
- Basic Equipped Kitchen
- Wi-Fi
- Utilities included
- Access to laundry facilities and basic cleaning equipment
- Linens
- Transport for London travelcard including unlimited travel in central London (zones 1 & 2) for the program duration
- One three-day, two-night field trip to a popular European destination, including transportation (flight or train), accommodation, and group activities
- Support for mental and physical health, including some professional appointments
- General orientation, cultural activities, and All-school field trips
- Syracuse Abroad Insurance, including emergency travel insurance
- Membership with International SOS Assistance, a medical & security advisory service
- Pre-departure materials and advising
- Fortifies the broad support we have in place for our students
- Includes services not covered by tuition and for which a separate fee is not charged
